The flea market will be ending one half hour earlier this year which necessitated a minor adjustment in the shift times for the Public Gate/Gate House All other shift times remain unchanged.


Please note that this year the Club booth positions will be assigned by the respective Club President, and all requests for these positions should be forwarded to your Club President.
