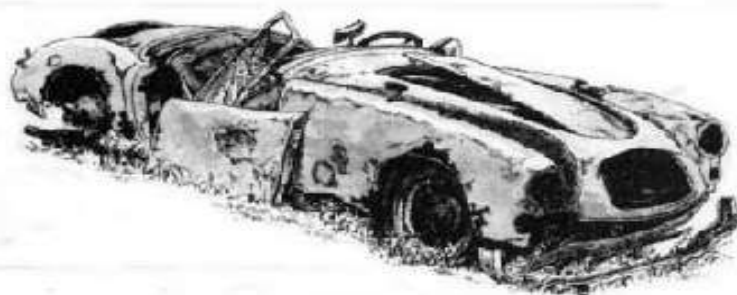

Please note the following changes for this year.

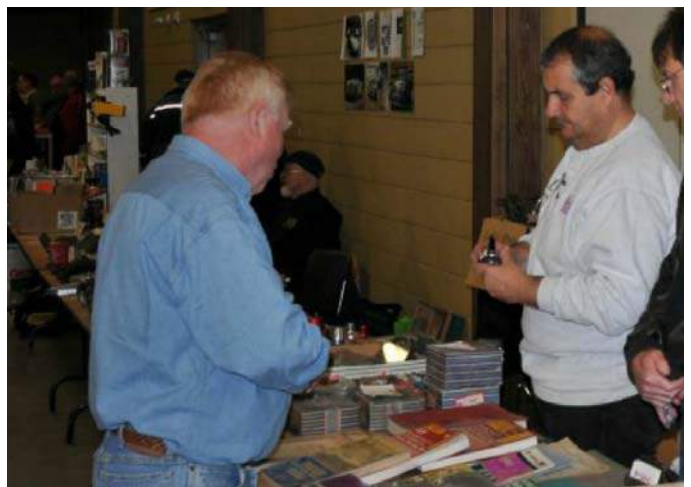
The flea market will be ending one half hour earlier this year which necessitated a minor adjustment in the shift times for the Public Gate/Gate House All other shift times remain unchanged.

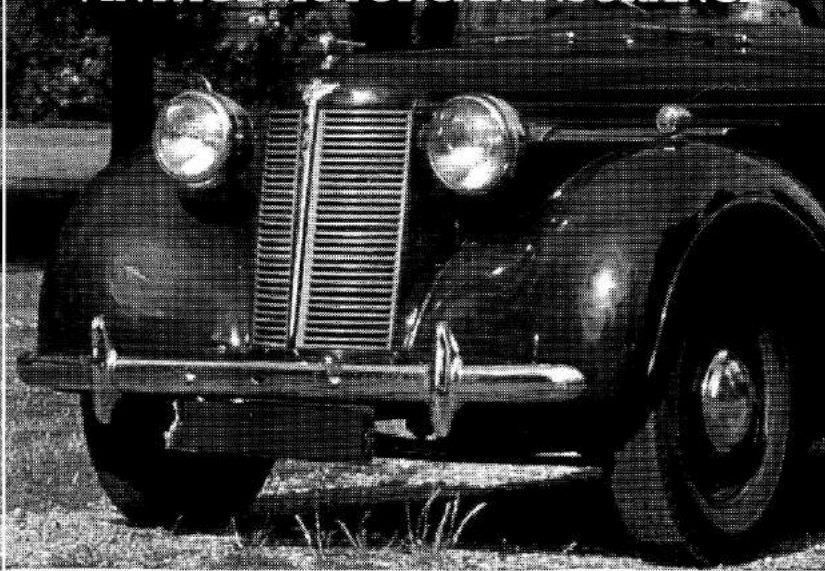
