

Well if you didn't make it to Cowbell on July 28th, you missed a good time!


There were 24 people from the Club in attendance and it was very nice to see some folks who don't normally come out to our events.

The current owner had a full, frame-off restoration completed in 2009. A new after-market frame was installed at that time. A new Dennis Welch alloy cylinder head was installed in October

2009 and the rad was re-cored at that time as well. A new premium quality chrome bumper and over-riders were installed in October 2018.
