A few of us ventured to the Toronto Metro Convention Centre to enjoy Super Tuesday at the Canadian International Auto Show.

Even though a few manufacturers were missing, it was a very good show and we had a great time. On walking in, the first thing we noticed was a Castrol GTX Classic high zinc motor oil sign.

Along with the many electric cars, there were lots of classics to see. For example, 1966 Ford GT40, Aston Martin DB2, and Buick Wild Cat.







There was a beautiful blue - prototype all electric Silverado with up to 754 horsepower with wide open watts and 785 lb-ft of torque, 0-96 km/h in under 4.5 seconds with wide open watts performance mode, 640 km range on a full charge and up to 10,000 pounds of maximum towing.





Afterwards we attended the Loose Moose for a wonderful dinner of great beer and burgers before heading to Union Station and Train rides home - no drinking and driving worries here!
